549,540 Kansans served by 11 YMCA associations

The Y provides a supportive environment for families of all backgrounds, ages, and abilities where people can meet their health and wellbeing goals through exercise, nutrition, and chronic disease prevention programs.

VOLUNTEERISM



5,427 volunteers donated 188,044 hours

The Y is the charity of choice for thousands of Kansans who donated \$32.3 million in 2021. These volunteers gave \$4.8 million worth of their time, talent and effort to better Kansas communities.

BUILDING CAREERS



3,254 Kansans employed

The Y employs neighbors to help neighbors. Kansas YMCAs employ thousands of full-time, part-time and seasonal staff—many of them youth. This large and diverse workforce is an economic engine in our state.

49,318 Kansas seniors connected

Kansas Y programs help prevent social isolation in older Kansas adults by allowing them to connect and engage in meaningful activities. Small lifestyle changes such as increasing physical activity, eating healthier and staying active socially can help older adults live better.

811,639 healthy meals & snacks served

As the pandemic interrupted school meal programs for kids and caused financial difficulties for families, Kansas Y's expanded their year-round food programs, started mobile food pantries and mobilized volunteers to serve the growing nutrition needs of children and families.

MEETING COMMUNITY NEEDS



\$13,163,936 given in financial assistance

Thanks to \$32.3 million in donations from generous community members, all Ys are able to offer direct financial assistance to individuals and families so they can participate in programs and services that enhance their health and wellbeing. Our child care assistance scholarships allow families to go to work knowing their children are safe and receiving quality care.

Hundreds of teens, young adults, and job seekers helped

Kansas YMCAs are creating innovative solutions to our state's workforce challenges. Our character development programs help young people cultivate the values, skills, and relationships needed in our future workforce. The Y's Job Prep program creates work-ready teens through training, development, and time/experience in the workplace. The Y Career Academy pays participants to fill desperately needed child care positions at the Y while preparing for a professional career in another growing industry.

THRIVING YOUTH




132,108 Kansas kids nurtured

The Y provides youth with the tools and resources they need to succeed in life. 5,183 kids and teens explored new interests, learned new skills and built relationships at 31 summer day and overnight camps. 3,740 children prepared for kindergarten in 19 early learning programs. 9,119 youth discovered support and friendship in 105 before and after school programs. 11,059 youth learned life-saving swim skills, and 28,602 kids learned teamwork and stayed active in our youth sports programs.
